Wildwood Days is Aug. 10-14 Parade to Honor Eldon Whitehead



As noted in the July issue, Eldon Whitehead of Fortuna will be the grand marshal in the 2016 Wildwood Days parade in Rio Dell on Aug. 13. The honor recognizes his lifelong commitment to the betterment of the region through dedication that continues to this day. He has contributed years of service to both the Rio Dell and Scotia fire departments; to the Boy Scouts of America from which he received the Order of the Arrow for his service; to area schools, and by fostering more than 250 children in crisis over 35 years as a foster parent together with his late wife, Francis. The pair was honored "a couple of times" by the county and state foster parent associations

for their service. In addition, Whitehead adopted and helped raise eight children.

Whitehead worked at Pacific Lumber, as it was called when he joined, for more than 41 years. During much of that time he lived in Scotia, moving to Fortuna in 1993 and retiring in 2000. Since then he has headed a dozen Facebook sites dedicated to preserving the history of various places close to his heart, sharing photos and information with a loyal following of friends, former coworkers and others both near and far who enjoy seeing his news and memories of this region. Today Whitehead spends about five hours each day online, managing the various Facebook sites. He remains active in the community, as clerk of the board of trustees for the Fortuna Union High School, and as an inspector at Fortuna election poll sites, among other responsibilities.

He recently married the former Margaret Shrull, a Fortuna High graduate who goes by Maggie. She was introduced to Whitehead's Facebook pages by her grown daughter after becoming widowed, and began contributing her own historic photos of the area, leading to their romance.
