Dollar General a hit with the community!

Dollar General opened in Rio Dell July 28, and has seen brisk business ever since. Manager Tracy Stowe says he's heard nothing but good comments from the community. A Scotia native, Stowe has 30 years' experience in retail business, including stints at grocery stores in Fortuna and Garberville. He trained at two Dollar General stores before opening this one. The store is just over 7,300 square feet, and employs nine people. "We offer core items at reasonable prices," Stowe says of the product line. "It's been a great thing for this town." He differentiates this business from other "dollar" stores by saying, "They only sell things that cost one dollar. We sell a full line of products; if you need it, we've got it." He likens the store, part of a 12,000 store chain, to "a mini Wal-Mart." The company describes itself similarly, saying on its web site that it is the nation's largest small-box discount retailer, adding, "We make shopping for everyday needs simpler and hassle-free by offering a carefully edited assortment of the most popular brands at low everyday prices in small, convenient locations." Begun in 1939 in Scottville, Kentucky, the store utilized innovative ways to reach out to its customers. Founder J.L. Turner knew tobacco farmers sold their product in a cold warehouse when they came to town, so he met them with half a pair of warm gloves, offering the other glove if they came to his store, where he would cash the checks they received for their crops. The Turner family turned the first of what had grown to be their chain of department stores into a Dollar General in 1955. Thirty years later, the chain purchased Eagle Family Discount Stores. Today, headquartered in Goodlettsville, Tennessee, the company has offices and distribution centers in many locations. Literacy is a major focus of the company. In spite of his marketing insights, founder J.L. Turner was functionally illiterate, with only a third grade education. The Dollar General Literacy Foundation honors the founder with over 20 years of helping individuals learn to read, prepare for the high school equivalency exam, or learn English as a second language. Since its inception, the Foundation has awarded more than \$97 million to nonprofit organizations and schools that have helped more than 5.8 million individuals advance their literacy and basic education skills. Brochures on the literacy program are available at cash registers in each store.

We encourage parents, teachers, members of the community, and bargaining unit leaders to attend.




